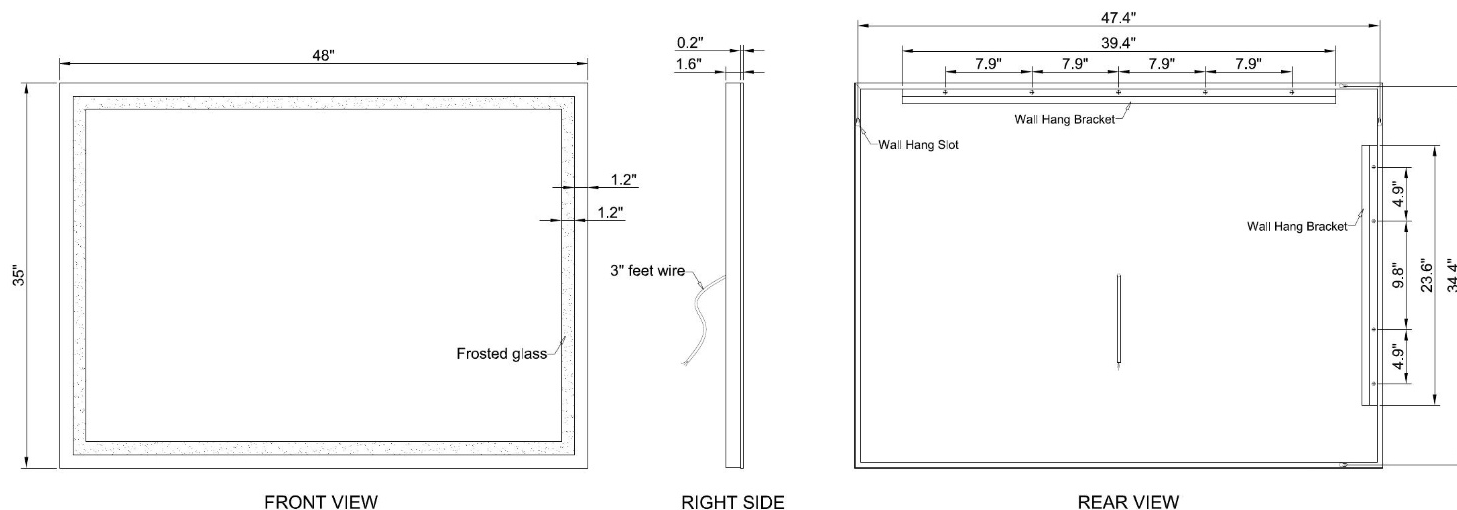

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## INSTALLATION

- Hold the Z-bar on the wall, level it, and mark screw points.
- Drill pilot holes; add wall anchors if not hitting a stud. Install Z-bar (wall piece) – Screw it firmly into place and keep it level.
- Hook the mirror's pre-installed bracket over the wall cleat.
- Match & attach 3 electrical wires from mirror to home electrical wires: Live to Live, Ground to Ground, Neutral to Neutral.

## CARE & SAFETY

- Wear suitable eye wear protection when drilling. Use caution when using power tools near water, beware of hidden cables or pipes.
- Be cautious if drilling on tiled surfaces in case the drill slips. Applying a piece of masking tape on the wall before marking out fixing holes can help stopping the drill from moving.

## CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

- It is recommended to clean the unit with a soft, dry, non-abrasive cloth when turned off.
- Never use cleaning agents or abrasive material on any type of surface finish.
- Do not strike glass components with hard or pointy items.
- Do not place very hot or cold items against or in close proximity to glass surfaces.
